F. Ashley Company the new requirements are:

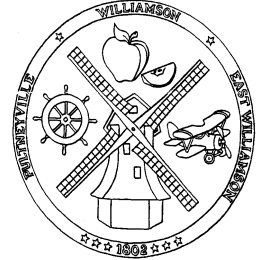
Commercial General Liability	\$ 1,000,000/occurrence 2,000,000 aggregate
Fire Damage Liability	50,000
Medical Expense	5,000/person
Umbrella Liability	1,000,000

The **Town of Williamson** is to be named as an additional insured on the vendor's policy. The motion was carried.

Insurance requirements are: Commercial General Liability \$1,000,000/occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate; Fire Damage Liability \$50,000; Medical Expense \$5,000/person; Umbrella Liability \$1,000,000.

STATUS: It is stipulated by and between the parties hereto that _____ (company/person in charge) is an independent contractor and that he/she/they may not in any capacity be considered an agent or employee of the Town or ever bind the Town to any obligation, or subject it to any liability whatsoever.

INDEMNITY: _____ (company/person in charge) agrees to defend at his/her/their expense, indemnify, and hold harmless the Town for acts, omissions, or decisions made by their agents, employees, invitees, and those under their control, while performing the contractual responsibilities under this agreement.

The actual point at which the fireworks are to be fired shall be at least two hundred feet from the nearest permanent building, public highway or railroad or other means of travel and at least fifty feet from the nearest above ground telephone or telegraph line, tree or other overhead obstruction, that the audience at such display shall be restrained behind lines at least one hundred and fifty feet from the point at which the fireworks are discharged and only persons in active charge of the display shall be allowed inside these lines, that all fireworks that fire a projectile shall be so set up that the projectile will go into the air as nearby as possible in a vertical direction, unless such fireworks are to be fired from the shore of a lake or other large body of water, when they may be directed in such manner that the failing residue from the deflagration will fall into such lake or body of water, that any fireworks that remain unfired after the display is concluded shall be immediately disposed of in a way safe for the particular type of fireworks remaining, that no fireworks display shall be held during any wind storm in which the wind reaches a velocity of more than thirty miles per hour, that all the persons in actual charge of firing the fireworks shall be over the age of eighteen years, competent and physically fit for the task, that there shall be at least two such operators constantly on duty during the discharge and that at least two soda-acid or other approved type fire extinguishers of at least two and one-half gallons capacity each shall be kept at as widely separated point as possible within the actual are of the display.
