<u>Appeal No. 798</u>: Michael and Christie Graves of 4236 Miller Street, Williamson, NY 14589. Applicants are requesting front setback relief for construction of a front porch. Property is owned by applicants and is located at 4236 Miller Street, Williamson. Zoned R-1.

Mr. Graves addressed the Board. He indicated that at present there is a brick stoop approximately 5 feet on the front of his house. He wishes to remove the stoop and build an 8' x 23' covered porch, making it 13 feet from right-of-way. Current zoning requires a 40-foot setback. Mr. Graves is asking for 27 feet of relief.

Chairman Norton asked Mr. Haywood if there were any concerns from the neighboring property owners. There were none.

There being no further questions from the Board, Jordan Szklany made a motion to grant Appeal No. 798 with 27 feet of relief on the north lot line. Tim Gulick seconded the motion. Upon roll call vote, all voted in favor of the motion.
