Agenda Items:

Appeal No. 747 – First Presbyterian Church of Williamson. A request for a special use permit to operate a not-for-profit youth coffee house. Property owned by Donald Camp, Paula Priest and Raymond Luke Cino and located at 4100 Ridge Road.

Joyce Bliek addressed the Board on behalf of the Presbyterian Church. She stated that the Church had found another location for their proposed youth coffee house. Luke Cino has agreed to rent the second floor of the above property to the Church for this use. Ernie Norton had a concern about handicapped accessibility. Mrs. Bliek said this is an issue because the building does not have handicapped accessibility. This question was posed to Mr. Haywood if this was a requirement for Code. Mr. Haywood stated that it may have to have some form of accessibility and a more comprehensive review per New York code because it is located on the second floor.

Kurt Allman motioned to refer Appeal No. 747 for a special use permit to the Planning Board for approval with the Board's concern of handicapped accessibility and the requirement of a sprinkler system. Leigh Furnal seconded the motion. Upon roll call vote, all voted to refer said variance to the Planning Board.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Ernie Norton to adjourn the meeting. Leigh Furnal seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 8:15 P.M.
