Regular meeting of December 28, 2015

Randy Peck called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

The Committee members reviewed the minutes from the November 23, 2015 meeting. A motion was made by Gary Orbaker to approve the minutes as submitted, seconded by Rick Vos. All were in favor. Motion passed.

New business:

 Stephen Schoen, 2787 Rosemarie Lane: Mr. Schoen presented an update on the drainage project he is working on in his neighborhood. This project involves digging a ditch on his property (lot #22) and neighboring property belonging to Steve and Cindy Harden (lot #21, 2809 Rosemarie Lane). He presented pictures he had taken to document the excavation work that is completed. The 10" drain tile on the East line of Lot #20 (2825 Rosemarie Lane) is open and flowing. The ditch is not completed yet as the property is too wet for the equipment to continue. Mr. Schoen reported that he had spoken with Lindsey at Wayne County Soil & Water in the past two weeks. She was going to send someone out but no one has been there or contacted Mr. Schoen. Randy will make a follow-up call.

Randy directed Mr. Schoen to apply for a 5-year drainage tax relief along with his neighbor Mr. Harden. Randy will contact the Assessor to let her know they will be in for the applications.

- Timothy Dostman, 4530 New Road: Kurt reported that the work on Christine Sackett's property will most likely be done in the next week.

Kurt reported that beavers had been removed from the creek behind Roger Bertou's property on Eddy Road.
