Public Comment: Bill Bishop, a new resident to Williamson, having recently moved here from Florida introduced himself to the Board. He and his family chose to settle in this area because of the lake's natural resource to use wind power for their electric. Bill and his family are very interested in pursuing this idea and are also looking at it as a business opportunity.

WHEREAS: Monies are needed to purchase watermain pipe and appurtenances for replacement of the watermain on East Townline Road from Ridge Road to Congdon Road,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That pursuant to provisions of Section 6-c of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York that the Town Board of the Town of Williamson be and hereby is authorized to expend funds from the Water Capital Reserve Fund the sum of \$75,000.00 for said purchases, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: This resolution shall be subject to a permissive referendum as permitted by law.

Supervisor Hoffman informed the Board the town books were ready for their review.

Councilman Warren has contacted Highway Superintendent, Jerry Hubright regarding snow removal at the Park. Jerry has agreed to keep it plowed.

Supervisor Hoffman announced there will be a work session on February 1, 2005 to meet with Michael Schaffron from Labella to discuss the reservoirs.

Councilman Monsees made a motion, seconded by Councilman Verno, that Paula Dolan be appointed as Deputy Town Clerk effective as of January 1, 2005. The motion was carried.

Councilman Monsees made a motion, seconded by Councilman Warren, that Paula Dolan be appointed as Deputy Registrar of Vital Statistics for a three-year term to commence January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2007. The motion was carried.

The Town Board has received from the Planning Board their recommendation regarding a request for a distance waiver of 20' instead of 30' for Phase II at Whispering Woods. The Planning Board has approved the waiver subject to Town Attorney review. The Planning Board is also concerned in light of the added ground cover, with the addition of garages and paved areas, how this will affect the drainage retention pond design.

The Town Board has received from the Planning Board a proposed addition to the Williamson Code covering "Energy Towers". This proposal will allow wind tower for residential use only and not for commercial use. The Board reviewed and discussed the proposal. Bill Bishop offered his suggestions concerning the proposal. Questions were raised concerning the noise level and where the towers could be located from property lines. The Board agreed to send the proposal with their suggestions and questions back to The Planning Board to clarify and make changes.

The Town Hall offices will be closed on January 17, 2005 in observance of Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday.

Councilman Warren made a motion, seconded by Councilman Monsees, to request the Supervisor to give permission for the temporary assignment of justices from other city/village/town courts in the Seventh Judicial District to our court as need arises, and to give consent to our Town Court Justices, for temporary assignment in other city/village/town courts as the need arises during the year of 2005. The motion was carried.

Councilman Verno presented the following Resolution and moved its adoption. It was seconded by Councilman Monsees.

WHEREAS: A new pick-up truck was budgeted for purchase for the Water Department, and

WHEREAS: A 2005 Dodge Dakota Club Cab 130" Wheel Base 4 x4 pick-up truck can be purchased under State-bid,
