WHEREAS: Said Town duly adopted on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of January, 2008, a resolution providing that said Town Board shall meet at the Town Hall, 8380 Route 21, Williamson, New York, on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2008 at 7:30 PM, to hear all persons interested in the matter of the extension of such Fire Districts, and the dissolution of the Williamson Rural Fire Protection District, and notice of such hearing having been duly published and posted as prescribed by law, and said Town Board has, at the time and place specified in said notice, duly met and considered the matter of such extension and dissolution and heard all persons interested in the subject thereof who appeared at such time and place concerning the same; and

WHEREAS: The evidence offered at such time and place requires that the Town Board make the determinations hereinafter made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: By the Town Board that it be and hereby is determined as follows:

- 1. That all of the property owners within the proposed extension of said Williamson Fire District, East Williamson Fire District and Pultneyville Fire District are benefited thereby.
- 2. That the Commissioners of the Williamson Fire District, East Williamson Fire District and Pultneyville Fire District have consented in writing to the extension of the Fire Districts as set forth herein.
- 3. That it is in the public interest to extend the existing Williamson Fire District, East Williamson Fire District and Pultneyville Fire District of said Towns to include the territory herein described.
- 4. That all property owners with the Williamson Rural Fire Protection District will be benefited by the dissolution of the Williamson Rural Fire Protection District with those property owners having their property included in the Williamson Fire District, East Williamson Fire District or Pultneyville Fire District as determined by the first response fire company as currently defined by the fire districts and as documented in the 911 Call System.
- 5. It is in the Public Interest to dissolve the Williamson Rural Fire Protection District; and be it.

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Town Board hereby does approve the extension of said Fire Districts of said Town, to include the territory herein described, and the said Fire Districts are hereby extended to include said territory, and be it,

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Town Clerk be and she hereby is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this resolution, in duplicate, in the office of the State Department of Audit and Control, at Albany New York, on behalf of the Town. And be it,

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Williamson Rural Fire Protection District is hereby dissolved.

John Manahan; Chief Operator of Wastewater mentioned that the DEC frowned on residents outside the district hooking into the Sewer District

Supervisor Hoffman announced there would be a two-minute recess before holding the next Public Hearing.

A notice having been published for a Public Hearing on the Public Nuisance Abatement Code regarding Railroad Avenue Trailer Park Property owned by Mr. Glen Houle [Houle Company LP], Supervisor Hoffman declared the Hearing open at 8:00 PM. The Supervisor explained a report had been submitted to the Town Board detailing unsafe conditions at 3880/3888 Railroad Avenue, Williamson, New York, known as Railroad Avenue Trailer Park, Tax Parcels: 65117-07-679879 and 65117-07-697875. The Town Board has reviewed the report and determined that the conditions at said property is unsafe and/or dangerous, and is a public nuisance. The cost of the clean up will go on the tax bills for this property. Steve Haywood informed The Board he had received a phone call from Mr. Houle he would not be attending the Public Hearing and wanted nothing more to do with the property. The Hearing was closed at 8:04 PM with a motion made by Councilman Verno, seconded by Councilman Bixby. The motion was carried.

Public Comment: John Manahan asked if zoning would stay the same after the clean up on Railroad Avenue property. Steve Haywood explained it was zoned for Commercial (C-3) and will remain.
