The cost for this seminar is \$200.00 per person with all other necessary and actual expenses a Town charge. The motion was carried.

Supervisor Hoffman made a motion, seconded by Councilman Orbaker that pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, the Town of Williamson agrees that monies levied and collected for the repair and improvement of highways shall be expended for 2015 as follows:

Supervisor Hoffman made a motion, seconded by Councilman Orbaker to grant permission to the Apple Blossom Committee, for use of the Town parking lots adjacent to 4100 Ridge Road for the carnival during festival days from May 14th - 17th, 2015. The motion was carried.

Councilman Orbaker made a motion, seconded by Councilman Watson to advertise in the official Town papers the week of March 29th, 2015 to receive applications for temporary part-time employees to work for the Water Department as outside laborers, on an as needed basis. Applications will be accepted until April 23rd, 2015 at 4:00 pm. The motion was carried.

Councilman Orbaker made a motion, seconded by Councilman Watson to declare the 1995 Ford L9000, 10 wheel dump truck as surplus, to be taken to the 30th Annual Palmyra Government Surplus Auction on Saturday, May 9th, 2015 in Palmyra, also the following items are declared surplus, and the Deputy Town Clerk is directed to advertise for bids the week of April 5, 2015 with bids being accepted until April 23, 2015 at 2:00 p.m.

- (1) Poly blend machine
- (2) four drawer file cabinets.
- (1) Huskavarna weed eater for parts, not running
- (2) sets of forks, one clamp on and one chain on for a bucket loader
- (1) new 10HP, 3 phase 100 gpm rotary lobe pump.

Councilman Orbaker made a motion, seconded by Councilman Watson to authorize the Superintendent of Highways to attend the intern training for the Cornell Local Roads program on May 27 - 28, 2015. There is no fee for attending the training. There is a \$60.00 charge to

participate in the project which will cover the cost of the CD for the software program. All other necessary and actual expenses will be a town charge. The motion was carried.

Councilman Orbaker made a motion, seconded by Councilman Watson to authorize the Town Supervisor to sign an engineering agreement with MRB Group for engineering of the following roads for watermain replacement: Ridge Road from Locust Street just past the Williamson Medical Center, Locust Street from Ridge Road to Congdon Road, Sherman Avenue, Congdon Road from Miller Street to 4400 Congdon Road, Old Ridge Road, and Willow Drive. The cost for these engineering services are not to exceed \$35,500.00.
