Councilman Warren made a motion, seconded by Councilman Verno, to close the parking lot, adjacent to the Presbyterian Church on Saturday, June 14<sup>th</sup> 2008 from 11:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. for a "Cub Mobile Derby". The Cub Scouts will furnish the Town of Williamson with proof of insurance listing the Town as an additional insured. The parking lot will be free from debris as a result of the derby. The motion was carried.

Phil Dean spoke of his concern with the carnival personnel poundings stakes in the pavement when they set up and would like to see it stopped due to the damage it is doing to the pavement.

Chris Pavlick, General Manager at Thatcher Company of New York presented their Annual 2007 CAP report.

Supervisor Hoffman presented the Wayne County "PROUD Partnership Award" to Deb & John Delyser, owners of the Liquor Cabinet. This award is given to retailers who sell or serve alcohol in Wayne County. The PROUD partnership is a coalition of representatives

from all Wayne County communities with the goal to increase awareness of the potential harms related to underage drinking; reduce the availability of alcohol to all youth under 21, and to change the community norms that are favorable towards underage drinking in Wayne County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Town Clerk is ordered to advertise in the appropriate papers the week of May 18, 2008 for said Public Hearing, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Town Board instructs the Town Supervisor to serve a notice to the owners of said property, Tilden & Eileen Johnson, 115 Timrod Drive, Rochester, New York 14617, in accordance with Section 135-7 that they will be required to attend the Public Hearing and that they have to commence the amelioration of the code violations sited in the code officers report and that those repairs must be made no later that 60 days upon service of notice.
