Councilman Orbaker made a motion, seconded by Councilman Bixby, to appoint the Town Supervisor, Anthony Verno, as the Certifying Officer for the NEPA process as part of the Baldwin Richardson expansion project. The motion was carried.

Councilman Bixby made a motion, seconded by Councilman Watson, to accept the resignation from Joseph Maliga, Building Inspector/Code Enforcement Officer, effective May 26, 2017. The motion was carried.

Councilman Bixby made a motion, seconded by Councilman Gowan, to hire Thomas Alexander for the Code Enforcement Officer/Building Inspector position. This will be a full time position at a rate of pay of \$46,000 annually. His date of hire will be Monday, June 19, 2017 and his probationary period will be for six months from the date of hire. The motion was carried.

Councilman Bixby made a motion, seconded by Councilman Gowan, to authorize the Town Clerk to advertise in the official Town papers the week of June 18, 2017 to hold a public hearing on proposed Local Law #1, 2017, to amend Chapter 68, BUILDING CODE ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE IV - Permits, Section 68-14 entitled Permits Required. The public hearing will be held at the regular Town Board meeting on July 11, 2017 at 7:30 PM. The motion was carried.

Supervisor Verno made a motion, seconded by Councilman Gowan, to authorize the Town Clerk to sign a software support and credit card usage agreement with Williamson Law Book Co. for the water/sewer program. The cost for this agreement is \$1,193.00. This agreement will be in effect from July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018. The motion was carried.

Councilman Watson made a motion, seconded by Councilman Gowan, to authorize the Town Supervisor to sign a Memorandum of Understanding between Wayne County Water and Sewer Authority and the following Towns: Williamson, Marion, Arcadia, Huron, Lyons, Sodus. The Memorandum is for the construction of a 2 million gallon water tank. The motion was carried.

Councilman Watson made a motion, seconded by Councilman Orbaker, to approve the disposal of dirt as per Consent to Entry and Release of Liability Agreement at 6181 Willow Drive, Williamson. The motion was carried.

Councilman Watson made a motion, seconded by Councilman Orbaker, to approve the disposal of dirt as per Consent to Entry and Release of Liability Agreement at 4258 Congdon Road, Williamson. The motion was carried.

Councilman Watson made a motion, seconded by Councilman Bixby, to approve the disposal of dirt as per Consent to Entry and Release of Liability Agreement at 6992 Bear Swamp Road, Williamson. The motion was carried.

Public Comment: Deborah Stritzel asked if the Town was going to apply for the "Lake Ontario Homeowner Recovery Fund" grant. Supervisor Verno explained that this grant program can be administered through participating municipalities and not-for-profit housing organizations. The Bishop Sheen Housing Foundation has applied and is administrating this program and at this time the Town will not be applying. Supervisor Verno also stated Governor Como was in Sodus Point today reviewing and answering questions regarding the damage caused by the flooding. A concern that was questioned was the issue of residency with no clear explanation. The governor is going back to Albany for clarification and other concerns in determining the eligibility for the grant money.

Supervisor Verno reminded the Board of the worksession scheduled for Thursday, June 15, 2017 and the discussion will be on changing the Drainage Law.
