Accelerator/Clarifier – Todd will get costs estimates from D & D welding for the troughs.

SCADA system – Todd will get cost estimates to upgrade the present system so it will be fully automated including remote monitoring.

Recycle/Backwash - John is to get estimates for equipment, piping, engineering, and DEC permits etc. to re-route backwash to the lake.

HVAC – Jim will have on the agenda for the next Town Board meeting a motion to request proposals to upgrade the heating system at the water plant.

Todd and John were asked to come back with their information in one month (September 20th).

Councilman Orbaker made a motion, seconded by Councilman Verno, to adjourn the meeting at 11:00 AM.
