Phil Dean, Todd Brennessel, Ora Rothfuss; Wayne County Planning Board, Tom & Sherry Watson, Eileen Loveman; Sun & Record, and the undersigned Town Clerk were also present.

Ora Rothfuss gave the Board an update on the progress that has been made regarding the Farmland Protection Project Doug and Paul Mason have agreed to participate in. The Mason's have agreed to sell their land south of Ridge Road, 247 acres to the Town through an easement. The County has prepared a grant for this process to be submitted to the State on Friday, September 12, 2008. Mr. Rothfuss has also put together a project budget summary and map to be submitted with the grant which he gave copies to the Board for their review. The grant if awarded will pay the Masons for their land, legal fees, closing costs, appraisals, surveys and any other costs entailed in this project. The Masons are hoping to get the estimated value of \$500,000 for their land. In return, they and anyone they sell it to gives up the right of development. These acres will have to remain farmland/green space forever. If the amount awarded for the State grant is not enough to cover the project, a grant to the Federal government will need to be submitted. The Town, if awarded the funds, will distribute the money as directed.

Supervisor Hoffman presented Tom & Sherry Watson, owners of the "Moongate Gallery & Antiques" located in the Lederer building in Pultneyville with the "Growing With Us" plaque. They opened their doors on August 8, 2008. Supervisor Hoffman thanked them for choosing Williamson in which to open their business and wished them much success.

Public Comment: Councilman Warren commented he did not want taxes to increase due to the Farmland Protection project.

Supervisor Hoffman made a motion, seconded by Councilman Warren, to accept the Consent Agenda containing the following items:

WHEREAS: The Town of Williamson intends to develop a memorandum of agreement with the Genesee Land Trust,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That Supervisor Hoffman is authorized to submit on behalf of the Town of Williamson with the Genesee Land Trust an application for funds for the Mason Farm to the NYS Department of Agriculture and Markets Farmland Protection Program.

Supervisor Hoffman noted the Town has no obligation in the expenditures towards this process.

Councilman Orbaker, made a motion, seconded by Councilman Bixby, to authorize the Town Assessor to attend a continuing education seminar on Valuation of Affordable Housing. The seminar will be held on October 10, 2008 at the Holiday Inn in Rochester, New York. The cost of this seminar is \$85.00 with all other necessary and actual expenses being a Town charge. The motion was carried.

Councilman Bixby made a motion, seconded by Councilman Orbaker, to authorize the Town Clerk to advertise in the appointed papers the week of September 21st and September 28th, 2008 a leaf removal program being provided by the Western Finger Lakes Solid Waste Management Authority. Residents may take leaves to the landfill site on Pound Road on Saturdays for the month of October from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. The motion was carried.

Supervisor Hoffman explained the only cost to the Town will be the labor for one employee to be on site each Saturday.
