BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That Highway Superintendent Kurt Allman is designated the Stormwater Coordinator for the Town of Williamson and is to represent the Town of Williamson at the monthly meetings of the Ontario Wayne Stormwater Coalition on the third Tuesday of every month at the Victor Town Hall, 9:30 AM in the second floor meeting room, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the above appointment shall commence immediately and remain in effect until such time as a Building Inspector is hired for the Town of Williamson.
