Public Comment: Rick Vos asked the Board how they felt about the response from the NYS DOT regarding the intersection on Rt. 104 and East Townline Road. Councilman Orbaker made a motion, seconded by Councilman Bixby, to direct the Town Clerk to advertise to hold a public hearing at the regular Town Board meeting on December 9, 2014, at 7:30 p.m., regarding proposed Local Law #2014-5 #2015-1to amend Chapter §166, Vehicles and Traffic, as follows: Chapter 166-8 A. On any public highway within the Town of Williamson and <u>on the west side of the municipal parking lot located between No. 4057 Ridge Road (Main Street) and 4069 Ridge Road (Main Street) and on the north side of the municipal parking lot located behind No. 4101 Ridge Road (Main Street) between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m. during the period beginning November 1 and ending April 1 of each year; and to add Chapter 166-8.1 **Special Purpose Parking Zones.** It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle or to allow the same to remain parked in any marked public parking areas located within the Business Improvement District as defined in Chapter 7-4 in excess of three consecutive hours except on Sundays. The motion was carried.</u>

Councilman Orbaker made a motion, seconded by Councilman Bixby, to authorize the Town Supervisor to sign an agreement with Rochester-Genesee Regional Transportation Authority, upon approval of the Town Attorney. The agreement is for the construction and maintenance of a bus shelter on property owned by the Town of Williamson. The location is at the Town Parking lot at 4100 Ridge Road. The motion was carried.

Councilman Bixby made a motion, seconded by Deputy Supervisor Verno, to authorize the Town Supervisor to sign a service agreement with Postler & Jaeckle Corp. for maintenance to the Aerco boiler system. The cost for this service will be \$856.00. The motion was carried.

Councilman Bixby made a motion, seconded by Councilman Orbaker, to authorize the Building Inspector's clerk to attend the Finger Lakes Building Officials Association Annual Business Meeting to be held on December 12, 2014 at Burgundy Basin Inn in Pittsford, New York. There is no fee for this meeting but all other actual and necessary expenses are to be a Town charge. The motion was carried.

Councilman Bixby made a motion, seconded by Councilman Orbaker, to authorize the Assessor's clerk to attend the Assessor's Association annual meeting to be held in Lyons, New York on December 9, 2014. There is no fee for this meeting but all other actual and necessary expenses are to be a Town charge. The motion was carried.

Councilman Bixby made a motion, seconded by Councilman Orbaker, to declare a 30" Troy-Bilt snow blower as surplus. The snow blower currently needs repairs and doesn't work. The Town Clerk is directed to advertise in the official town papers the week of November 23, 2014 with bids being accepted until December 5, 2014 at 3:30 pm. The snow blower can be seen by calling the Superintendent of Highways, Kurt Allman at 585-748-6931. The motion was carried.

Deputy Supervisor Verno made a motion, seconded by Councilman Orbaker, to authorize the Town Supervisor, and the Clerk to Supervisor to attend the New York State Government Finance Officers' Association seminar: On the State of the Economy, Fund Balances and OSC Audits. The seminar will be held at the Locust Hill Golf Club on Jefferson Road in Rochester, New York, December 11 from 11:00 am until 4:00 p.m. The registration fee for this seminar is \$90.00 per person with all other actual and necessary expenses a Town charge. The motion was carried.

Deputy Supervisor Verno presented the following Resolution and moved its adoption. It was seconded by Councilman Bixby.

Whereas: The Town of Williamson wishes to adopt the Deferred Compensation Plan for Employees of the State of New York and Other Participating Jurisdictions (the "Plan") for the voluntary participation of all eligible employees; and

Whereas: The Town of Williamson is a local public employer eligible to adopt the Plan pursuant to section 5 of the State Finance Law*; and

Whereas: The Town of Williamson has reviewed the Plan established in accordance with Section 457 of the Internal Revenue Code and section 5 of the State Finance Law of the State of New York; and

Whereas: The purpose of the Plan is to encourage employees to make and continue careers with the Town of Williamson by providing eligible employees with a convenient and tax favored method of saving on a regular and long-term basis and thereby provide for their retirement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Town of Williamson hereby adopts the Plan for the voluntary participation of all eligible employees; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the appropriate officials of the Town of Williamson are hereby authorized to take such actions and enter such agreements as are required or necessary for the adoption, implementation, and maintenance of the plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Administrative Services Agency is hereby authorized to file copies of these resolutions and other required documents with the President of the State of New York Civil Service Commission.

The pre-registration fee is \$100.00 per person. All other actual and necessary expenses are to be a Town Charge. The motion was carried.

Deputy Supervisor Verno made a motion, seconded by Councilman Bixby, to authorize the Senior Account Clerk to attend a Williamson Law Book Company-Payroll Software Program workshop on Wednesday, December 3, 2014 at the Town of East Bloomfield Town Offices. There is no cost for this workshop and all other actual and necessary expenses are to be a Town charge. The motion was carried.

Councilman Orbaker made a motion, seconded by Deputy Supervisor Verno, to authorize the Town Supervisor to sign an agreement with Dr. Kristna Persaud reappointing him as the Williamson Health Officer. The appointment begins on December 10, 2014 and will end on December 9, 2018. The motion was carried.

Councilman Orbaker made a motion, seconded by Deputy Supervisor Verno, to hire Cody Chelini as a temporary laborer for the Highway Department. The rate of pay is \$15.00 per hour. The motion was carried.

Deputy Supervisor Verno made a motion, seconded by Councilman Orbaker, to authorize Lock Out – Tag Out training to be given by Empire Safety. The cost for this training will be \$800.00 for the Highway, Water and Wastewater Department employees. The motion was carried.

Discussion took place with the Board, John Manahan and Kurt Allman regarding replacing a fire hydrant on Ridge Road near the Town parking lot. Two hydrants were previously removed and everyone agreed at least one should be replaced. Question now is where it should go. Deputy Supervisor Verno asked that they work that out and bring it back to the Board for approval.

Public Comment: Fedele Noto asked if the an annual report was presented to the Board every year from the Master Plan Committee. The Board explained the process.
