The Town will remove the snow and the school district is to pay one half of that cost $(\$ 35.00)$. The motion was carried.

Councilman Verno made a motion, seconded by Councilman Monsees, to authorize the Town Clerk to advertise in the Sun \& Record issue of November 17, 2005, to receive bids for high lift pumps at the Water Treatment Plant. Bids will be received until December 21, 2005 at 2:00 PM at which time the bids will be opened and read. The Town Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids. The motion was carried.

The Board agreed to sign a three-year contract with the Wayne County Water \& Sewer Authority and the minimum would be for fifty million $(50,000,000)$ gallons of water. The current contract will expire on December 31, 2005.
