Dear Williamson Resident,

In 1991, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued the Lead and Copper Rule (LCR) as part of its enforcement of the Safe Drinking Water Act. The regulations were implemented to protect people from exposure to lead through their drinking water. In 2020, the EPA expanded the LCR, requiring municipal water authorities to document service line materials in customer-owned service lines.

Beginning November 1st, the Town of Williamson will be creating an inventory of customer waterlines. This will require you to self-report your service line material or have a member of the water department enter your home to ascertain the material of the service line pipe.

To self-report, you can complete the enclosed form or fill it out online on the Town's website at town.williamson.ny.us.

To set up an inspection appointment, call the Town of Williamson water plant at 315-589-3781.
